Thin Blue Fault Line - Policing America John C. Franklin 2021-02-22 Authors Franklin and Hein have witnessed firsthand difficulties experienced in some black communities. They use their knowledge to analyze and discuss the interactions between American policing, a subculture of the black community and the BLM movement.
